

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 1032**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO BUDGETS AND FINANCE, REVISING THE 2013 BUDGET, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 1017 and 1027.

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville prepared a budget pursuant to RCW 35A.33 for the fiscal year 2013, based upon estimated revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville amended that budget based to account for new revenues and expenditures via ordinance 1027; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville has new expenditure needs that were previously unanticipated, and therefore must increase the 2013 budgeted expenditures. Such unanticipated expenditures include subsidies from the general fund to the water and sewer funds, additional staff costs in the street fund, additional supply and electricity purchases in the street fund, and additional contracted labor in the sewer fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 2013 Amended Budget.

The 2013 Budget is hereby amended as follows:

General Fund	\$670,814	\$672,000
Street Fund	\$43,803	\$45,000
Sewer Fund	\$250,191	\$254,000


Section 2. Severability.

The provisions of this ordinance are declared separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or portion of this ordinance or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the ordinance, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. Published and Effective Date.

A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect five days after its publication.


