

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 1054**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING CREATING A NEW SECTION OF MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING COUNCILMEMBER AND MAYOR PAY

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville is an optional municipal code city organized and existing under the provisions of Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the mayor's salary has not been updated for many years; and

WHEREAS, It has become increasingly difficult to attract qualified candidates to the city council; and

WHEREAS, both the mayor and councilmembers donate significant time and personal resources to promote the City's health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. New NBMC Section 1.05.

Section 1.05, Mayor and Councilor compensation, of the North Bonneville Municipal Code (NBMC) is created as follows:

1.05.010 Council Compensation

Commencing with the calendar year 2016 or the commencement of a new term of office, whichever is later, councilmember's elected or appointed subsequent to the previous year's general election shall receive \$25 reimbursement per city council regular meeting attended, not to exceed two meetings per month.

1.05.020 Mayor Compensation

Commencing with the calendar year 2016 and thereafter, the mayor shall receive a salary of \$735 per month. The mayor, serving in this capacity, shall not be eligible for overtime, holiday pay, medical benefits or other benefits.

1.05.030 Pro-Tem Compensation

In a case where a pro-tem mayor fills the mayor's position for at least one full month, the pro-tem shall receive the mayor's compensation in his/her stead for each full month served. For existing council members, this provision shall become effective during a new term of office.

1.05.040 Effective Date

As provided in Washington State Constitution Art. 11§ 8, NBMC 1.05.010 does not permit an increase in the salary of any of the existing councilors during their present term of office, but shall only establish a salary for those councilors during a subsequent term of office beginning from the time they take office.

1.05.050 Expense Reimbursement

Each member of the city council and the mayor shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred in the discharge of their official duties upon presentation of a claim therefore after allowance and approval by the city council as evidence by a voucher signature. Reimbursement for mileage shall be at the current rate allowed by the Internal Revenue Service for business travel.

Section 2. Severability.

The provisions of this ordinance are declared separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or portion of this ordinance or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the ordinance, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. Published and Effective Date.


A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2016.
