RESOLUTION NO. 440**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
CREATING A FEE FOR LIVESTOCK PERMITS.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 994, regarding livestock regulations, was passed on November 22, 2011, but no fee was set at that time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission finds that while the administrative cost associated with permitting livestock are about \$65 per application, a fee of \$65 would be unduly burdensome; and

**WHEREAS**, a fee of \$30 for the initial application and \$20 for annual renewals would be less burdensome, while still recovering a significant portion of the cost; and

**WHEREAS**, residents with current permits would be grandfathered and would owe no fee unless they make a change to their use of livestock;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the fee for livestock applications shall be \$30 and that permits shall be renewed annually per ordinance 994 for \$20.
