Resolution Number 474

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of North Bonneville Washington, authorizing Mayor Don Stevens to submit a Community Development Block Grant [CDBG] Application to the Washington State Department of Commerce and certifying the application complies with state and federal laws and specific program requirements.

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville, Washington, through its legislative authority, authorizes the Mayor to apply to the State Department of Commerce for a Community Development Block Grant [CDBG]; and

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville, Washington has identified a community development and capital facilities priority need for which to seek CDBG funds; and

Whereas, it is necessary certain conditions be met to receive CDBG funds; and

Now, Therefore, be it resolved the City Council of North Bonneville, Washington, authorizes submission of the attached CDBG application to the state Department of Commerce for purposes of requesting up to \$400,000 to replace a 40 year old sewer lift station that is completely worn out, whose present condition poses a clear and present threat to community life, health and safety, and certifies that, if funded, it:

Will comply with all applicable state and federal laws and specific program requirements;

Will comply with applicable provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended and other applicable state and federal laws;

Has provided and will provide opportunities for citizen participation that satisfy the CDBG requirements of 24 CFR 570.486;

Will not use assessments against properties owned and occupied by low- and moderate-income persons or charge user fees to recover the capital costs of CDBG-funded public improvements from low- and moderate-income owner-occupants;

Has established or will establish a plan to minimize displacement as a result of activities assisted with CDBG funds; and assist persons actually displaced as a result of such activities, as provided in the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended;


Has adopted a policy to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in accordance with RCW.235.070 and certifies this project will adhere to its policies;

Will conduct and administer its program in conformance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Fair Housing Act; and will affirmatively further fair housing (Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968); and

Has adopted (or will adopt) and enforce a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and has adopted (or will adopt) and implement a policy of enforcing applicable state and local laws against physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location that is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstration within its jurisdiction, in accordance with Section 104(1) of the Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act or 1974, as amended; and

The City of North Bonneville, Washington designates Mayor, Don Stevens, as the authorized Chief Administrative Official and the authorized representative to act in all official matters in connection with this application and the City of North Bonneville, Washington's participation in the State of Washington CBDG program.


