  - Consultant role is to help develop technical documents to support SMP update
- Draft shoreline jurisdiction map (Rona Spelleccacy / Mike Witter)
  - City's shoreline jurisdiction must include (RCW 90.58.030(2)(f)):
    - Rivers and streams with more than 20 cubic feet per second (cfs) mean annual flow
    - Lakes and reservoirs greater than 20 acres in area
    - Shorelands associated with these water bodies
      - Lands extending landward 200 feet in all directions from OWHM
      - Floodway plus contiguous floodplain 200 feet landward from floodway
      - Associated wetlands
- Draft shoreline inventory mapbook (Rona / Mike)
  - Data sources
    - USGS data provided by Ecology (qualifying rivers and lakes)
    - County and City maps (wetlands, floodway, parcel data, land use/zoning)
    - Ecology and WDFW data (habitat data, other?)
    - Land ownership (BLM, County)
    - Other??
  - Mapbook will be used to develop Shoreline Inventory and Characterization Report – next step in SMP process

  - Shoreline inventory and characterization report – draft report due to Ecology 12/30
