**Meeting Call to Order:** 6:30 pm

**Guest Presentations:** Introductions were done for the new Law Firm of Wyers, Haskell, Davies & Dunn.

**Public Comment:** M. Hamilton talked about the Police Survey and the previous records he had in his possession.

C. Jermann said she was in agreement with M. Hamilton and that the numbers were wrong. She was in favor of the Skamania County Sheriff's Office.

M. Armantrout read a letter she wrote about the police survey and city police coverage for the city.

L. Sass gave the Mayor and Council a letter her husband wrote.

J. Runkles stated he was not in favor of removing the second public comment from the agenda, and wants Councilmember Owens to excuse himself from action regarding any union issues.

M. Showalter stated concern about the costs reflected on the Police Survey.

J. Nappe requested clarification of the figures stated by M. Armantrout.

S. Runkles stated she was in favor of the Skamania County Sheriff's office.

**Consent Agenda:** T. Dudley moved to approve the consent agenda. J. Lambson

**seconded.** D. Sullivan asked where the minutes of March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2010 were. Mayor Stevens stated “The minutes were not completely completed. So they have been held back until next meeting.” D. Sullivan then responded that she had asked for a copy of those minutes and couldn’t find anything wrong with them. **Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, D. Sullivan – yes. J. Lambson – yes, C. Owens - yes.**

**Council Member/Staff Comments:** T. Dudley questioned as to why the survey document had been changed. Mayor Stevens explained that it was easier to have a public respond to a one page document and that it was a compromise with the union on the figures presented.

Mayor Stevens read a message from P. Sullivan of MRSC that explained his change in position and opinion regarding the Mayor’s ability to file a PERC clarification on the clerk/treasurer position.

**Announcements/Reports:** J. Lambson & T. Dudley spoke on the favorable results of the Audit done by the State of Washington.

M. Owens reported that she had been notified by the City of Stevenson that the building inspector fees were not going to increase for 2010. She also reported on the upcoming training for Land Use and Planning to be held in Stevenson on June 1, 2010.

D. Sullivan reported on the Chamber of Commerce meeting she attended.

**Unfinished Business:** D. Sullivan stated she had some concerns regarding the new attorney contract.

M. Owens requested a new attorney contract change in the terms of payment from 15 days to 30 days.

C. Owens stated that he had informed the Mayor that he will be abstaining from discussions and voting regarding union negotiations.

There was discussion regarding the union negotiations and membership on the negotiating committee. **T. Dudley moved to form a negotiating committee that consists of J. Lambson, D. Sullivan, J. Stratton-Pies, T. Dudley and Mayor D. Stevens. J. Lambson seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, D. Sullivan – yes. J. Lambson – yes, C. Owens - Abstain.**

**New Business:** Mayor Stevens stated that he had the Council Rules of Procedure put in the council packet for future review and changes that are needed.

**Legal Issues:** T. Wyers stated that there were new opinions regarding the Public Record Requests.

**Adjournment:** D. Sullivan moved to adjourn at 7:30 pm. J. Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes, D. Sullivan – yes, C. Owens - yes.
