Meeting Call to Order: 6:30 pm

Guest Presentations: D. Stevens gave the council a proposal to request funding of \$2,900 from Hotel/Motel tax for an upcoming disc golf tournament.

Public Comment: M. Hamilton read a letter to the council expressing his concerns and questions for the council.

C. Jermann spoke on the Budget, fighting the union, and grievances.

M. Repar spoke to the council regarding the resolution for the Parks and Recreation District to be created to save the County Pool.

M. Armantrout spoke on a 911 issue, compromise in government, and volunteers.

P. Taylor was very concerned regarding speeders on Cascade Dr. and asked to have speed bumps installed.

S. Lyddon talked about the speed bump in Stevenson and stated he was not in favor or supporting the resolution for the County Pool.

J. Blackwell also expressed his concern regarding the speeders on Cascade Dr.

S. Vigil thanked the council for the Police Survey and spoke in favor of the resolution for the County Pool.

J. Nappe stated she supported the Sheriff contract, wants a budget and clarification of the tax that would be charged to the residents if the County pool resolution passed.

C. Lewis stated she supported the Sheriff contract, but was not in favor of supporting the County pool.

S. Sass spoke regarding the speeding that was happening on Evergreen Dr. too.

He also was concerned about the condition of the roadways (Evergreen and Cascade) with the large dump trucks traveling those roads.

B. Charlton spoke on the new Greenleaf Trail signs and the speeding on Evergreen.

R. Pies stated he would donate the gravel for the speed bumps if needed or help with a monetary donation for a stop sign.

T. Herzig also expressed concern regarding the speeding and spoke on the former Police Chief's unemployment claim.

(Councilmember C. Owens left meeting at 7:20 pm.)

C. Jermann spoke on the speeding taking place on Cascade Dr.

J. Runkles stated that temporary speed bumps could be used during the non-winter months, and then be removed for winter as not to interfere with plowing.

Consent Agenda: T. Dudley moved to approve the consent agenda. J. Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes.

Council Member/Staff Comments: T. Dudley spoke regarding the budgets of 2009 /2010.

J. Lambson spoke regarding grievance issues and the Sheriff's contract.

J. Stratton-Pies spoke regarding the proposal of the stop sign along Cascade Dr.

Announcements/Reports: M. Owens reminded the council that there was training being held in Stevenson, Tuesday, June 1st entitled A Short Course on Planning and that 3 of our council members had signed up to attend. T. Dudley stated he was not going to be able to attend due to a conflict.

Unfinished Business: T. Wyers read a paragraph from the Collective Bargaining Agreement regarding contracting outside of the union. He also informed the council that the incarceration contract had expired in December, but there would be a new contract coming.

T. Dudley moved to approve the Sheriff's Office Contract for Law Enforcement Services. J. Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes.

T. Dudley moved to approve Resolution #410, opting in to be a part of the new Parks and Recreation District subject to the approval of the city attorney. Jennifer Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – no.

New Business: There was discussion by council regarding the necessity of a Labor Law Attorney being present during negotiations. T. Dudley stated he felt the city attorney should be in attendance also. **T. Dudley moved to have a labor law attorney present for negotiations and to also have the city attorney present. Jennifer Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes.**

Legal Issues: T. Wyers reported to the council that there was a “positive tone” when he was discussing the Law Enforcement Contract with Sheriff Brown and the prosecuting attorney. He also addressed M. Hamilton’s questions.

T. Dudley moved to approve \$2,900 in funding out of the Hotel/Motel tax fund to the N. Bonneville Disc Golf Association. J. Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes.

Adjournment: J. Stratton-Pies moved to adjourn at 8:45 pm. J. Lambson seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes.
