


# City of N. Bonneville July 2009 Newsletter

Have you seen any blue arrows on the pathway? These mark the first Heritage Trail Hamilton Creek Trail. The trail begins and ends at the downtown station (the dark brown gazebo in the CBD by the bear). Maps are available in the station and at city hall. Why not get out and explore the trail and the new interpretive signs today!

N. Bonneville Fire Department is all volunteer. When you hear the fire signal it means that the department is being called out. In the case of a city emergency the fire signal will blow 3 consecutive times. If this happens an "audio only" message will be transmitted on our city cable TV system.
