Applications for funding for 2010 events are available and must be received at City Hall by October 30, 2009, 5:00 pm. Applications will go to the City Council for review and approval at their meeting on November 10th.

Work on the upper Hamilton Creek is under way and should be completed no later than October 15th. The project consists of bank restoration and channel improvements that should help prevent flooding of Greenleaf Lake and Hamilton Creek.

The lower Hamilton Creek project is done except for the planting of the banks.

Pathway repair under the highway bridge on Hamilton Creek is also being done. This will protect the path from future damage during high water occurrences.


