## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON FOR 2026, SETTING THE AD-VALOREM TAX

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120, the City of North Bonneville has given proper notice of a public hearing to be held on October 28<sup>th</sup> and November 25<sup>th</sup>,2025 to consider the City's Budget for the fiscal year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville City Council, after said public hearing and duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that the City of North Bonneville requires an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property, any increases in the values of state assessed property, and any increases resulting from the addition of newly annexed parcels, for meeting the expected expenses and obligations for the provision of ongoing services; and

WHEREAS, the population of the City is less than 10,000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby for the levy to be collected in the 2026 tax year. The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount for the previous year shall be \$2,592.15, which is an increase of 1% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred, and any refunds made.
