WATERING TIME!!!

Summer water rates started on May 1st!!! Base rates remain at \$26/month for water and \$45/month for sewer, but your consumption will go from \$1.90 down to only \$1.00 per 100 Cubic Feet (around 700 Gallons!) UPDATE: The system failed to apply the discounted rate before bills went out! They are fixed in the system and if you paid the higher amount, you will have a credit next time! We are EXTENDING the special rate through October 31st because of the mistake!!! We do this to encourage keeping our neighborhoods from becoming a fire hazard through the dry season, and you get to beautify your yards, fill up a pool, or play in the sprinklers!!!
