A Message from the City Clerk

URGENT REMINDERS:

It is very important, especially in inclement weather that you and your guests **do not park on the streets!** Snow plows and EMS vehicles need the ability to safely and effectively navigate our neighborhood! Our public works department are authorized to start plowing whenever necessary to ensure our safety throughout the winter. Please remember to leave roadways open for Emergency Services vehicles and snow plows to access quickly and safely, this includes your vehicles, self, pets, and kiddos! NOTE: If we get huge amounts of snowfall, please contact Mayor Sabo or myself if you are able to provide any snow-clearing assistance.

Your safety is important to us! There are a few things to remember to keep you, your loved ones, and your properties safe and warm... Remember to cover exposed pipes and leave a trickle of water dripping if we are below freezing temps, please do not use fireplaces/heaters/etc. without cleaning and proper ventilation to prevent fires and carbon monoxide poisoning, never use outdoor stoves inside, and be sure to have all of your detectors tested regularly! If you know of neighbors who are alone and elderly or have health issues, it never hurts to see how they are doing during extreme weather circumstances.
