UTILITY RATE NOTICE:

Every March, City Council decides on a reasonable rate increase for our utilities that ensures we are keeping up with increasing costs of labor and maintenance. Starting in March, the rates will be as follows:

Water Base: \$29.40 per month

Water Consumption: \$2.10 per 11 cubic feet

Sewer Base: \$49.80 per month
