**Guest Presentations:** Noah Adams spoke regarding the creation of a Parks & Recreation District for perseveration of the County Swimming Pool.

**Public Comment:** C. Jermann presented figures on city lost revenue and questioned as to how the council planned on handling it.

T. Herzig stated he wanted to try and resurrect the positive ideas presented by J. Meyer when he was on council. He then proceeded to thank J. Runkles for his efforts in making the council meeting minutes available on a website.

J. Runkles stated he would volunteer to assist the finance committee.

B. Porter offered her services to also assist the finance committee.

**Consent Agenda:** **T. Dudley moved to approve the consent agenda. J. Stratton-Pies seconded.** D. There was discussion regarding the Minutes of March 23, 2010.  
**T. Dudley moved to amend the original motion to exclude the minutes of March 23, 2010. J. Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results on amended motion: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, D. Sullivan – yes, J. Lambson – yes. Voting results on original motion as amended: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, D. Sullivan – yes, J. Lambson – yes.**

Council decided to table the minutes of March 23, 2010 until the next meeting.

**Council Member/Staff Comments:** T. Dudley reported on the negotiating committee and stated too much time is being spent on the minutes. He also addressed financial issues.

Mayor Stevens addressed the e-mail received from Skip Rand of RCAC regarding the next procedures for the water/sewer rates. These discussions lead to a discussion of payroll breakdowns. Mayor Stevens stated he would call Skip himself and get clarification.

**Unfinished Business:** None

**New Business:** **T. Dudley moved to approve the Agreement for Contract Services for the Treatment plant subject to approval by the attorney. D. Sullivan seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes, D. Sullivan – yes.**

It was the consensus of the city council to have all contracts go through legal counsel prior to presentation to the city council for approval.

Mayor Stevens requested the council approve funding and acquisition of a labor law attorney to resolve PERC and union issues. **T. Dudley moved to allow Mayor Stevens to proceed with a labor law attorney. J. Lambson seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – no, J. Lambson – no, D. Sullivan – no.**

Mayor Stevens reported on the Law Enforcement Survey. 550 surveys were sent out, received back 370. 243 were in favor of having a Sheriff Contract, 120 in favor of Local Officer, 7 no preference. Mayor Stevens stated he would get with the Sheriff and have a contract completed for the next meeting. J. Lambson requested he have the start date of the contract as the current date and not back date it to the first of the year.

**Legal Issues:** L. Haskell spoke on the flow of questions presented to the attorneys on behalf of the city. She also suggested a policy be established and included in the council procedures.

**Adjournment:** **D. Sullivan moved to adjourn at 8:15 pm. J. Stratton-Pies seconded. Voting results: T. Dudley – yes, J. Stratton-Pies – yes, J. Lambson – yes, D. Sullivan – yes.**
