ADMINISTRATOR REPORT

August 22, 2017

A \$50,000 chip seal grant was submitted to TIB last week.

John Spencer is out of town so no budget discussion this week but on September 12, 2017, we will resume with the workshop starting at 6:00 P.M. rather than 6:30 P.M.

We are revising the Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) and once it is done, we will revise the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). Ultimately, the TIP gets folded into the CIP. The TIP will be sent to Dale at RTC and he may include it in the STIP.

I will be applying for the TAP grant to improve our pathways Spring of 2018. Maximum amount is \$200,000. Local match is 13.5%.

Columbia River Gorge Commission, August 22 at 9:30 A.M. held today.

Meeting with Pat Albaugh regarding Coyote Ridge capacity. He is prospecting future businesses.

First Public Hearing on the Budget will occur Sept 12 at 7 P.M.

Last week, I provided some info on commercial rates for entities such as Foundations Recovery Network. Once we have concurrence, I will prepare a resolution for your review.

- Other garage sale input:

- Friday night barbecue dinner – Julie and Diane reported that it was a big success. Served 155 meals. They are definitely a go for 2018. Not sure yet of the profit.
 - Chairs, tables and tablecloths were a big help.
- Friday night entertainment was very well received.

 - Next year, post “reserved” signs on Gazebo for kids' crafts.
- Kids Zone inflatable rides, better use than last year.

IDEAS FOR NEXT YEAR:

- Earlier concert? Open mic during the day.
- Better directional signage at t-intersection as cars arrive.
- Additional signage at entrance to City Hall parking lot as cars arrive.
