City Attorney's Report: Shares that there is a lot going on in the civil side regarding the possibility of flock camera footage being beholden to public records requests. Share that she will keep everyone updated.

Planner's Report: Shares that the first grant has been received that they he will be starting on the second year of periodic review work and the critical areas ordinance. Shared that new construction on a duplex is starting and that a new manufactured home will be getting put in on a vacant lot.
