City Council Meeting Minutes September 8, 2020 7:00 p.m.

Meeting Call to Order: 7:00pm

Roll Call: Present; Councilmembers J. Acton, T. Norris, M. Lee, R. Hall. Absent; Mayor B. Sabo, Councilmember T. Randall (arrived 7:28pm)

Consent Agenda:

- **Approval of the August 25th meeting minutes. Approval of the September 1st -half Vouchers for \$17,724.94:** Motion by T. Norris, second by M. Lee. **Passed 4-0**

Mayor's Comments: Mayor Pro-Tem J. Acton states that the Mayor would like all to know the union negotiations will be starting soon.

Chief Administrative Officer Report: Deanna Adams states that there was a misquote on Visions SQL update. It was stated that Vision would charge \$500 for the upgrade and now shows \$3500. Strongly suggesting changing Financials/Payroll/Utility vendor.

City Attorney's Report: The Governor extended the no in-person meeting order at least through the end of September.

Unfinished Business:

- **COVID-19 Update Councilor Acton:** One more reported case, but it is a person who had previously tested positive and is now positive again.
- **PDA Business sale proposal update:** The board came up with a selling price and the Mayor asked to also have a list of liabilities. They are scheduled to report at the next council meeting. They are about to have an SAO audit as well.
- **NB Shoreline Environmental Designations map:** Tom explains that these are maps he has been waiting for. It will still be a process of at least a month for finalization and public hearings.

New Business:

- **Joshua Tree Consulting Contract Extension not to exceed \$3000:** Motion by T. Norris, second by R. Hall. J. Acton explains that the priorly approved money has run out with all of the PDA activity. Needing to extend to finish the job until sold. **Passed 4-0**
- **2021 Budget Discussion:** Councilor Acton explains that we will be resuming 6:30 workshop meetings starting at the next council meeting. In the packet is a timeline of due dates. Ken adds that the workshop is a separate "special" budget meeting to include a notice on the door and a

copy to the local paper (not for publication) at least 24 hours prior to the meeting. Public is welcome and there must be a way for them to dial in. Separate zoom meeting needed. Deanna asks if there needs to be a vote to allow workshops. Ken replies that a consensus is enough.

- **Excuse Mayor Sabo and Councilmember T. Randall:** Motion by T. Norris, second by R. Hall. Passed 4-0.

Closing Public Comment: N/A

Closing Council Comments: R. Hall asks about an RV trailer and car parked by the TV Tower on Cascade. J. Acton replies that it will be checked on. M. Lee adds that there is an RV and there is a lady sleeping in a car there. Deanna replies that she will let the Mayor know. M. Lee also adds that there is approval for the youth soccer to use the fields and they have offered to pay for new soap pumps for the bathrooms. Deanna adds that we need to arrange a meeting regarding the details of the deal with the Mayor, there was previous talk of replacing sprinkler heads that apparently never happened. Margie added that she requested for watering to start in the field and it has not. R. Hall also brings up ATV traffic and would like to know the rules. J. Acton responds that they need helmets, to be licensed, proper lights, etc. and that there is an ordinance. Tom asks if he gets riders at night as they do by the hot springs. R Hall responds that he has seen several racing through. Deanna adds that they are supposed to follow street laws and speed limits. R. Hall also mentions vehicles entering Celilo via the walking paths and wonders if they have permission. Tom says no. J. Acton says that Pat is the code enforcement officer and has moved over there and hopefully will diminish that issue. Deanna adds that Public Works and the motorcycle guy who sprays mosquitos are the only ones with permission to drive the paths currently. R. Hall also asks about the newly resurfaced tennis courts and if there is any monitoring of the area. T. Norris explains that there is no monitoring and it is an open court. There are not supposed to be skateboards in there, but no guarantees. Terry also states that the court will soon be striped. R. Hall also asks about the Gorgenet pricing and if anything was found out. Deanna replies that nothing has been passed to her and will have to ask Mayor Sabo. T. Norris says he still needs people to help out on the court and could use a snapline if anyone has one. It is in process of being completed hopefully this weekend. M. Lee asks if there will be pickleball lines. T. Norris responds that there will be and they will be different colors. J. Acton states that Councilor Randall arrived at 7:28. T. Randall adds that he wants to thank everyone for coming. He also mentions that coming around the corner towards his house, there were two bicyclists riding in the middle of the road and he said to use the bike paths and they flipped him off. He responded that there are several miles of bike lane to use safely.
