**Meeting Call to Order-** 7pm

**Consent Agenda: Approval of the September 24<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting minutes and October 1<sup>st</sup> half vouchers-** Travis R motions, Terry N seconds, Travis R- Yes, Terry N- Yes, Margie L-Yes, Joshua G- Yes. Taurus B- not yet present

**Guest Presentations: Justin Gross Skate Park:** Cancelled by presenter.

**Public Comment:** Cindy Dunn- Community garden manager makes an amendment to the revenue sources portion of the budget presented and gives more accurate revenue numbers to the mayor.

**Councilmember Comments:** Joshua G says thanks you to Deanna for her years of service. Travis R also says thank you.

**Sheriff’s Report:** The sheriff shared that there have been some “problem turkeys” in town as well as coyotes and that citizens dealing with both has resulted in firearms being discharged in town. She shared the legality of this and stressed the importance of not discharging firearms in town. She also shared some about the new flock cameras that she obtained via a grant, their capabilities, and the planned locations of these. She also shared that they have been increasing patrol in city limits.

**Mayor’s Report:** He shares that the increased patrols are appreciated.

**Chief Administrative Officer Report:** She thanks everyone for being so supportive during their time here.

**City Attorney’s Report:** Nothing to report.

**Planner’s Report:** Shared that things have been “pretty quiet.” There has been potential development but no applications yet. Meetings have been postponed for this reason.

- **Approval of Janette Tucker to fill Clerk/Treasurer position-** Travis R motions, Terry N seconds. Joshua G abstains and excused himself from discussion. All present councilors vote yes.
- **Approval of Resolution # 581, Authorizing Investment of City Monies in the LGIP-** Travis R motions, Joshua G seconds, all councilors vote yes.
- **Approval of Resolution # 582, Authorizing Signers on Financial Accounts-** Travis R motions, Terry N seconds, all councilors vote yes.
- **Approval of Personal Service Contract not to exceed \$5,000 for Administration Consulting Services, Deanna Syron-** Joshua G motions, Travis R seconds, all councilors vote yes.
- **Council will adjourn to executive session in accordance with RCW 42.30.110 (1)(i)(iii).** Executive session begins at 7:41 and adjourns at 8:03. The mayor is not present for second half.

**Closing Public Comment:** Jeff Blakely asks some questions regarding a letter included in the council packet as public comment regarding the Hamilton Island landfill. The mayor shares some background regarding this and that he would be keen to know more if indeed there is any issue with toxic materials or substances in the landfill. Quincy Anderson asks about whether or not a certain topic was discussed in executive session. City attorney reminds that executive sessions are confidential.
