Agenda Changes & Additions: Mayor Sabo requests that we add votes on city half days for Year’s and Christmas Eves, skipping the 2nd half meeting for December that falls on Christmas Eve, and to vote on paying our law enforcement bill when it arrives as opposed to waiting for the January meeting. Public Comment: Jeff Blakely notes that there is a pothole starting to form on Hot Springs Way under the railroad bridge were the pavement was recently redone. He voices concern that this is going to revert to it’s previous condition within a few years. Jennifer Kackely expresses curiosity about the city ordinances regarding ebikes. Noting that she wonders if it might become a popular recreational activity in town in the coming years and states she would like to know the council’s position on it. They mayor shares the current ordinance (they are allowed and must stay under 10 mph).

Councilmember Comments: Baxter and Randall both say thank you. Good speaks to the challenges and triumphs of the last year.

Sheriff’s Report: Notes that crime has been down and that they have been doing a healthy amount of traffic warnings. She gives updates and trainees and academy graduates within their deputy team. She notes that almost all of the flock camaras have been installed. She also gives an update about looking forward and planning for the hot springs resort reopening.

Mayor’s Report: Mayor Sabo gives background regarding the relocation of the city. He also shares that the Hot Springs Resort has already hired about 11 locals and plans to allow locals to use the pool facilities.

Clerk’s Report: Janette shares about the rate study and asset inventory the city is undergoing and what that means for the city.

City Attorney’s Report: The city attorney noted that they didn’t have anything to share at the moment.

Planner’s Report: The planner has given their notice and is not present at the meeting.
