Councilmember Comments: T. Randall thanks all for coming and would like to rectify his statement from the last meeting regarding the vote for PUD Commissioner and that it is a county vote, not just for the City of North Bonneville.

Mayor's Comments: Mr. Sabo mentions that the committee list is included in the packet and will take volunteers for positions at the next meeting.

Chief Administrative Officer Report: Deanna has nothing to report but wishes everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.

City Attorney's Report: Ken seconds Deanna's comment.

Unfinished Business:

COVID-19 Update Councilor Acton: Because J. Acton is absent, Mayor Sabo gives the report.
 There are now 166 positive tests out of 1242 tests given. 150 recovered, 6 have been hospitalized, and we remain at one death for the county.

New Business:

- Ordinance # 1131 amending Ordinance # 1115 License Agreement Gorgenet: Motion by T.
 Randall, second by T. Norris. Passed 4-0
- Ordinance # 1132 amending Ordinance # 1119 2020 Budget: Motion by T. Randall, second by R. Hall. Mayor Sabo explains that we spent an additional 14k in the street fund related to road fixes by Hot Springs, fixing the bridge separation, and hiring help to cut back all the blackberries near the Hot Springs. He also mentions that the budget change is usually near \$100k, so it is an improvement. Passed 4-0
- Vote on new pump for lift station #1, not to exceed \$23,000: Motion by T. Randall, second by T.
 Norris. Sabo explains that the current pump we were going to repair is outdated and would

need custom parts made. R. Hall asks if we should also purchase a backup pump and Mayor Sabo responds that we will likely send the old one in on an insurance claim to have as a backup. He also explains that all of the pumps have backups aside from this one. **Passed 4-0**

• Vote to excuse J. Acton: Motion by T. Randall, second by T. Norris. Passed 4-0
