

**City of North Bonneville Public Comment Period and Public Hearing  
Shoreline Master Program Final Adoption**

Notice is hereby given that the City of North Bonneville City Council will accept written and verbal comments on final changes to and adoption of a combined comprehensive update and periodic review of the City's Shoreline Master Program (SMP) as required under the authority of the Shoreline Management Act (RCW 90.58.080), consistent with the implementing rules and SMP Guidelines of WAC 173-26. After a lengthy local process, City Council previously approved this updated SMP (Resolution #554) and authorized submittal of the proposed amendment to Department of Ecology for state review. Ecology has issued a conditional approval decision contingent on a handful of final changes, mostly minor corrections/clarifications. The City must consider the final changes and locally adopt the new SMP by ordinance. Upon final action by Department of Ecology, the goals, policies, regulations, and environment designations of the new SMP will entirely replace the City's original 1974 SMP and will be codified in Title 21 of the North Bonneville Municipal Code.

Public comment on the final changes to the updated SMP will be accepted starting July 11, 2024, the public comment period will close upon the closing of the second public hearing described below. Send comments to:
