

**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT (SEPA)
DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE**

As lead agency under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Rules [Chapter 197-11, Washington Administrative Code (WAC)], the City of North Bonneville must determine if there are possible significant adverse environmental impacts associated with this proposal. The options include the following:

- **DS = Determination of Significance** (The impacts cannot be mitigated through conditions of approval and, therefore, requiring the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS));
- **MDNS = Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance** (The impacts can be addressed through conditions of approval), or;
- **DNS = Determination of Non-Significance** (The impacts can be addressed by applying the City Code).

Determination:

Determination of Non-Significance (DNS). The City of North Bonneville, as lead agency for review of this proposal, has determined that this proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (e). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and the 2026 Critical Areas Ordinance and Periodic Plan Updates as they apply to the City's Municipal Code and adopted standards.

Date of Publication and Comment Period:

Publication date of this DNS is **March 25, 2026**, and is issued under WAC 197-11- 960. The lead agency will not act on this proposal until the close of the 15-day comment period, which ends on **April 8, 2026**.

SEPA Appeal Process:

A final decision on this proposal will not be made until after the comment period described above. An **appeal** of any aspect of this decision, including the SEPA determination and any required mitigation, must be filed with the City of North Bonneville within fourteen (14) calendar days from the date the notice of that final decision is mailed to parties of record. The appeal must be in writing and should contain the following information:

1. The case number designated by the City.
2. The name and signature of each person or group (petitioners) and a Statement showing that each petitioner is entitled to file an appeal as described in ESHB 1724 Section 415. If multiple parties file a single petition for review, the petition shall designate one party as the contact representative with the City Clerk. All contact with the group regarding the petition, including notice, shall be with this contact person.
3. A brief statement describing why the SEPA determination is in error.
