

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 1100**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING NORTH BONNEVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 8.20 NUISANCES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville has determined that clarification of North Bonneville Municipal Code Chapter 8.20.080 Nuisance declared--Odors, fumes or smoke is needed to better address types of odors that is considered a public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, the violation/penalty section of the chapter should reflect the updated standard of referencing the fines and fees be referenced to Title 7 North Bonneville Municipal Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of North Bonneville do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.

Amending Chapter 8.20.080 Nuisance declared--Odors, fumes or smoke as follows:

The erection, continuances or use of any property, building, room or other place in said City ~~for the exercise of any trade, employment or manufacture~~, which by occasioning noxious exhalations, offensive odors or other annoyances, is discomforting or offensive or detrimental to the health of individuals or the public.

Section 2.

Amending Chapter 8.20.210 Nuisance--Violation/penalty as follows:

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter or who shall create, keep or maintain any nuisance as herein defined shall be guilty of a misdemeanor ~~and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) and/or imprisonment up to thirty (30) days in the County Jail~~ punishable by a fine in accordance with Section 7.01.020(C) of this code.

Section 3.

Severability.


