

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 1106**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE AMENDING
ORDINANCE 983 BY INCREASING THE BALANCE OF THE
TOURISM FACILITY FUND.**

WHEREAS, in 2006 the City Council voted to budget \$60,000 for a tourist facility; and

WHEREAS, the City passed Ordinance 983 reaffirming this intent and established a Tourism Facility Fund; and

WHEREAS, the amount of tourism related tax revenues has been reduced since the closure of the Bonneville Hot Springs Resort; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to make the most beneficial use to the remaining tourism fund balances.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE,
WASHINGTON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1.

Creation Transfer of Funds.

The City Treasurer is hereby directed to ~~create a new fund~~ maintain a Tourism Facility Fund for the purpose of constructing a tourist facility and to transfer ~~\$60,000~~ funds from the Tourism Promotion and Development Fund to provide seed money creating a total fund balance amount of \$200,000 ~~for this fund.~~

Section 2.

Severability.

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3.

Effective Date and Publication.


This ordinance shall become effective five days after its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication as provided by law.


