

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 1113**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING
NORTH BONNEVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 20 ZONING.**

WHEREAS, updating of certain chapter definitions is needed to address uses that are conducted within City zones; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville after careful consideration and study has deemed it necessary and desirable to amend certain sections of the zoning code to better reflect the current needs of the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of North Bonneville do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.

Amending TITLE 20 ZONING as follows:

Chapter 20.12 Definitions

Add Section 20.12.345

20.12.345 Overnight Lodging.

A classification of land uses where an owner or manager receives or seeks compensation for use or occupancy of visitor accommodations for a period of less than 30 consecutive days per rental period and which are subject to taxation under NBMC 3.02 Hotel/Motel Tax - excise tax on furnishing of lodging. Overnight lodging includes Bed & Breakfast, Campground, Hostel, Hotel, Motel, Vacation Rental Home, and other similar uses.

Section 3.

Severability.

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 4.

Effective Date and Publication.


This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication of the Ordinance, or a summary thereof consisting of its title, in the official newspaper of the City.


