CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE ORDINANCE NUMBER 1138

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING NORTH BONNEVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 6.04 ANIMAL CONTROL.

WHEREAS, the City has deemed that dogs have been allowed in designated play areas within the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville has deemed it necessary and desirable to regulate the use by dogs of such public places to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the residents; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to amend Chapter 6.04 of the NBMC to prohibit the use by dogs of such areas of city.

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of North Bonneville do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.

Amend Chapter 6.04 Animal Control as follows: Add new section

Section 6.04.110 Dogs Prohibited - Exceptions.

Except for service dogs, it is unlawful for a person who owns, has interest in, harbors or has charge, care, control, custody or possession of a dog, to permit to be in or on a playground, tennis court, basketball court, soccer field, baseball field or bleacher within any public park area of the City.

Section 2.

Severability.

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3.

Effective Date and Publication.

This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication of the Ordinance, or a summary thereof consisting of its title, in the official newspaper of the City.
