## ORDINANCE NO. 1073

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017.

WHEREAS, public hearings for the 2017 budget were held on November 8<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, following said hearings the City Council did approve and authorize such adjustments and changes as it deemed necessary and proper, and determined the allowances in fund:

# NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

#### Section 1. 2017Budget Adoption.

The 2017Budget for the City of North Bonneville is hereby adopted at the fund level in its usual form and content as set forth in the document entitled "City of North Bonneville 2017 Budget," and copies of which are on file in the Office of the Clerk.

## Section 2. <u>Estimated Sources and Uses By Fund</u>.

The totals of 2017 estimated revenues and expenditures for each separate fund are set forth in a summary form below, and are hereby appropriated for expenditure at the fund level during the year 2017 as set forth in the "City of North Bonneville 2017 Budget."

A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2017.
