

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 1089**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING  
CHAPTER 2.08 APPOINTIVE OFFICES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Bonneville is an optional municipal code city organized and existing under the provisions of Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington; and

**WHEREAS**, the City previously passed Ordinance 1060 which authorized the positions of Clerk and Administrator/Treasurer; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to revise these titles to better reflect the current responsibilities of the positions;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE,  
WASHINGTON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**

**Amending  
CHAPTER 2.08 Appointive Offices as follows:**

**2.08.005       Offices.**

In accordance with RCW 35A.12.020, the City shall provide two appointive offices, the office of Clerk Deputy Clerk/Treasurer and the office of the ~~Administrator/Treasurer~~ City Clerk.

**2.08.010       Administrator / Clerk / Treasurer separated into the positions of Clerk and  
Administrator / Treasurer.**

Pursuant to Section 35A.12.020 of the Revised Code of Washington, the office of Administrator / Clerk / Treasurer is hereby separated into the positions of Clerk Deputy Clerk/Treasurer and ~~Administrator / Treasurer~~ City Clerk.

**2.08.020       Appointment.**

The offices of ~~Clerk and Administrator / Treasurer~~ Deputy Clerk/Treasurer and City Clerk shall be appointed by and shall hold office at the pleasure of the Mayor, upon confirmation of the City Council.

**2.08.025       Compensation.**

The compensation of the City Clerk shall be ~~\$34,000~~ \$42,600 [annually] and the compensation of the ~~Administrator / Treasurer~~ Deputy Clerk/Treasurer shall be ~~\$55,000~~ \$42,600 [annually]. These compensations shall be modified from time to time though budgetary process or according to an adopted pay plan.

**Section 2.**

**Severability.**

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

**Section 3.**

**Effective Date and Publication.**

This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication of the Ordinance, or a summary thereof consisting of its title, in the official newspaper of the City.


