

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 1103**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE AMENDING NORTH BONNEVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 12.12 PATHWAYS – MOTORIZED VEHICLES BY AMENDING SECTION 12.12.040.

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville, after careful consideration and study, has determined that golf carts should only be subject to the same restrictions as other excepted vehicles per 12.12.030 relating to inspection and insurance, and

WHEREAS, pedestrians, non-motorized vehicles as defined in Section 12.12.010, and motorized wheelchairs shall continue to have the right-of-way over these vehicles, and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

**Amending
CHAPTER 12.12 Pathways – Motorized Vehicles as follows:**

NBMC 12.12.040 Golf cart permits

Golf carts shall be subject to an annual permit fee as set by resolution of the City Council. ~~and must be inspected and approved by a representative authorized by the city. Proof of liability insurance must be presented at the time of inspection and be in the operator's possession when operating on city property or property open to the public.~~ Golf carts are only authorized to cross a city street to get to another public pedestrian pathway. They shall not travel over 100 feet in either direction on a city street, except for the Hamilton Creek Bridge on Cascade Drive where crossing will be allowed. Minimum age to operate a golf cart shall be sixteen (16) years.

Section 2.

Severability.

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3.


Effective Date and Publication.

Effective Date and Publication.


This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication of the Ordinance, or a summary thereof consisting of its title, in the official newspaper of the City.


