

**CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 1171**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING  
CHAPTER 1.05 MAYOR COMPENSATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Bonneville is an optional municipal code city organized and existing under the provisions of Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Council is responsible for setting mayoral compensation and may adjust the compensation during a mayor's term; and

**WHEREAS**, the mayor's salary was last updated by Ordinance 1124; and

**WHEREAS**, the mayor donates significant time and personal resources to promote the City's health, safety and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the upcoming budget preparation and process and mayoral transition will take significantly more time and resources than have been previously recognized or allocated by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the compensation proposed is commensurate with a regular full time job that is anticipated over the coming months;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE,  
WASHINGTON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**

**CHAPTER 1.05 Mayor Compensation as follows:**

**1.05.020       Mayor Compensation.**

Commencing ~~January 1, 2025~~ October 1, 2025 and thereafter, the mayor shall receive a salary of ~~\$4,017~~ \$10,350 per month. Commencing on January 1, 2026 the mayor shall receive a salary of \$4,017 per month. The mayor, serving in this capacity, shall not be eligible for overtime, holiday pay, medical benefits, or other benefits. Commencing January 1, 2025, the mayor shall also be eligible for a \$890.00 per month stipend to offset medical benefit coverage. The Mayor may be eligible for participation in PERS in accordance with Department of Retirement System rules and regulations. (Ord. 1168, 2025 Ord. 1124, 2020, Ord. 1102, 2018; Ord. 1090, 2018; Ord. 1054, 2015)

**1.05.030 Pro-Tem Compensation**

In a case where a pro-tem mayor fills the mayor's position for at least one full month, the pro-tem shall receive the mayor's compensation including medical benefit stipend in his/her stead for each full month served.

**Severability.**

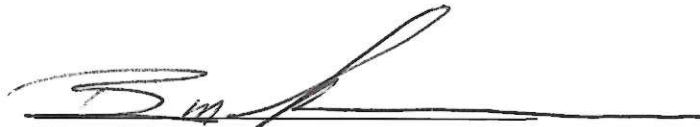

This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication of the Ordinance, or a summary thereof consisting of its title, in the official newspaper of the City.
