A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS, ESTABLISHING A MEANS OF  
VALUATION AND METHOD OF PROPERTY DISPOSAL

**WHEREAS**, certain pieces of equipment owned by the City no longer have practical application, pose storage and safety liabilities and should be disposed of, but may have some residual value; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is authorized by RCW 35A.11.01 to establish a value of discarded property and authorize its sale by Council resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined the value of the discarded materials to be equivalent to the items present scrap metal value, less any handling, transporting, advertising and disposal cost.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the City of North Bonneville hereby declares the following property to be surplus and authorizes it to be sold, traded, or disposed of in a manner deemed to be in the best interest of the City.

1 8" Quartz Valve, Model SE N 90, Serial no 124185, \$0.11 Per pound


1 60 KW back up generation which was replaced during the modernization. Motor Cast, \$0.11 per pound, generator part copper \$0.42 per pound

Additionally, an assortment of scrap materials with no practical application too numerous to describe


