RESOLUTION NUMBER 489**

A Resolution of City of North Bonneville DECLARING SPECIAL MARKET CONDITIONS AND AN EMERGENCY UNDER RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) to purchase a used backhoe

WHEREAS, City of North Bonneville of Skamania County is a Washington Municipality as defined in RCW 39.04.010;

WHEREAS, the City maintains heavy equipment for earthwork, primarily for its sewer and water systems; and


WHEREAS, the City's existing backhoe is past its useful life and must be replaced with a newer and lower hour model, and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has an opportunity to purchase a local used 1996 Case 580SL backhoe for \$23,000 and the seller, Paul Lambson, is willing to accept the City's backhoe as a trade-in for \$6,000, making the net cost \$17,000, and

WHEREAS, the cost of similar used 1996 Case 580SL backhoes appear to be between \$22,900 and \$25,000 but the comparable backhoes are in other areas of the country and would require shipping at an additional cost. Additionally, other comparable backhoes have considerable more hours of operational usage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of City of North Bonneville hereby declares a special market condition pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) for the purchase of a 1996 Case 580SL backhoe from Seller Paul Lambson for a price of \$23,000 minus the trade-in value of the City's backhoe of \$6,000 for a net price of \$17,000. The City Administrator, Steven Hasson, is hereby directed to consummate the sale and the Mayor is authorized to sign any title documents necessary to complete the purchase and sale.
