

**City of North Bonneville  
Resolution 496**

**A Resolution of the City of North Bonneville, Washington acknowledging the periodic review and findings of the Resource Lands and Critical Areas Ordinance.**

**Whereas**, RCW 36.70A.130(5) provides that the City of North Bonneville is required to review and possibly update the Critical Areas Ordinance, and;

**Whereas**, the City of North Bonneville passed Ordinance 815 in 2010 that adopted Resource Lands and Critical Areas, and

**Whereas**, the City amended the original Resource Lands and Critical Area Ordinance with Ordinances 926 in 2007 adding species and habitat of local importance, Ordinance 939 in 2008 amending to comply with Best Available Science, Ordinance 942 in 2008 to adopt Washington State Department of Ecology recommendations and Ordinance 1046 on January 15, 2015 updating the wetland rating system to conform to state recommendations, and;

**Whereas**, the City identified that there are no Resource Lands including agricultural lands, forest lands or mineral resource lands within the city, and;

**Whereas**, the City submitted the current Critical Areas Ordinance 1046 that was adopted in 2015 to various state agencies for review and possible updates and received no input to amend the current ordinance, and;

**Whereas**, staff forwarded its analysis and input to the City of North Bonneville Planning Commission who held a public hearing on February 21, 2017. Based on its review of Ordinance 1046, Chapter 36.70A RCW, the analysis prepared by staff, agency and public comments received, the Planning Commission found that no amendments are needed to the Critical Areas Ordinance and recommended that the North Bonneville City Council adopt Resolution 496 stating these findings, and;

**Whereas**, this Resolution and Planning Commission recommendation were submitted for the required state agency review under RCW 36.70A.106 with a finding by the Washington State Department of Commerce on March 13, 2017 that the City of North Bonneville has met the Growth Management Act notice to state agency requirements in RCW 36.70A.106.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City of North Bonneville City Council** that the city has reviewed North Bonneville Municipal Code Title 21.10 Resource Lands and Critical Areas and Ordinance 1046 relating to the state requirements to review and possibly update and has determined that code is compliant with state requirements and that no update is needed.


