**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BONNEVILLE, WASHINGTON DECLARING
CERTAIN PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS, ESTABLISHING A MEANS OF VALUATION AND
METHOD OF PROPERTY DISPOSAL.**

WHEREAS, certain pieces of equipment owned by the City no longer have practical application, pose storage and safety liabilities and should be disposed of, but may have some residual value; and


WHEREAS, the City is authorized by RCW 35A.11.01 to establish a value of discarded property and authorize its sale by Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined the value of the discarded materials to be equivalent to the items present scrap metal value, less handling, transporting, advertising and disposal cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of North Bonneville, Washington hereby declares the following property to be surplus and authorizes it to be sold, traded, or disposed of in a manner deemed to be in the best interest of the City:




