

**City of North Bonneville
Resolution Number 519**

**A Resolution of the City of North Bonneville, Declaring Special Market Conditions Under
RCW 39.04.280(1)(B) to purchase a used Type 6 Brush Squad Truck.**

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville is a Washington Municipality as defined in RCW 39.04.101; and

Whereas, the City maintains fire trucks and equipment used by the North Bonneville Fire Department for emergency response; and

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville Fire Department has need for a Type 6 Squad Brush Truck to adequately address emergency response in the portions of the city that are not serviced by fire hydrants; and

Whereas, the City intends to seek a pre-owned Type 6 Squad Brush Truck under special market conditions due to the unique circumstances surrounding a pre-owned vehicle, and provided the price is favorable, purchase the vehicle and obtain Council ratification of the purchase at the next Council meeting; and

Whereas, the City has an opportunity to purchase said Type 6 Squad Brush Truck as specified by the DNR Grant Equipment Justification and Certification Statement utilizing said grant, private donations and appropriated city funds; and

Whereas, the deadline for the DNR grant is March 15, 2019 including submittal of all documentation which limits the time to search and acquire said truck.

Whereas, this resolution follows a voice vote at a regular city council meeting of December 11, 2018 authorizing the purchase of a Type 6 Squad Brush Truck not to exceed \$45,000.00, with this purchase to be ratified by the City Council at the first city council meeting after purchase.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, the City Council of North Bonneville, Washington hereby declares a special market condition pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) and authorizes the purchase of a Type 6 Squad Brush Truck for a purchase price not to exceed \$45,000.00 The City Council shall ratify upon purchase of said truck at its first regular council meeting. The City Clerk is hereby directed to consummate the sale and the Mayor is authorized to sign any title documents necessary to complete the purchase and sale.


