

**City of North Bonneville
Resolution Number 526**

**A Resolution of the City of North Bonneville, Declaring Special Market Conditions Under
RCW 39.04.280(1)(B) to purchase a used Manlift Bucket Truck.**

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville is a Washington Municipality as defined in RCW 39.04.101; and

Whereas, the City maintains Vehicles and equipment used by the Public Works Department for Maintenance and Operations; and

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville Public Works Department has need for a Manlift Bucket Truck to adequately address street and trail light repair and City Tree maintenance throughout all areas of the City; and

Whereas, the City intends to seek a pre-owned Manlift Bucket Truck under special market conditions due to the unique circumstances surrounding a pre-owned vehicle, and provided the price is favorable, purchase the vehicle and obtain Council ratification of the purchase at the next Council meeting; and


Whereas, the City has an opportunity to purchase said Manlift Bucket Truck which is a 2002 Ford F-750 Manlift Bucket Truck with Terex 60 ft. working height boom with appropriated city funds;

Whereas, this resolution follows a voice vote at a regular city council meeting of April 23, 2019 authorizing the purchase of the 2002 Ford F-750 Manlift Bucket Truck with Terex 60 ft. working height boom not to exceed \$28,000 including purchase price, taxes and licensing, with this purchase to be ratified by the City Council at the first city council meeting after purchase.


Now, therefore, be it resolved, the City Council of North Bonneville, Washington hereby declares a special market condition pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) and authorizes the purchase, upon a favorable certified boom inspection, of a 2002 Ford F-750 Manlift Bucket Truck with Terex 60 ft. working height boom for a purchase price with taxes and licensing not to exceed \$28,000.00. The City Council shall ratify upon purchase of said truck at its first regular council meeting. The City Clerk is hereby directed to consummate the sale and the Mayor is authorized to sign any title documents necessary to complete the purchase and sale.


