City of North Bonneville Resolution Number 527

A Resolution of the City of North Bonneville, Reaffirming Special Market Conditions Under RCW 39.04.280(1)(B) and Ratifying the Purchase of a Used Manlift Bucket Truck.

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville is a Washington Municipality as defined in RCW 39.04.101; and

Whereas, the City maintains Vehicles and equipment used by the Public Works Department for Maintenance and Operations; and

Whereas, on April 23, 2019 the City Council adopted Resolution 526 authorizing the City of North Bonneville Public Works Department to purchase a pre-owned Manlift Bucket Truck to adequately address street and trail light repair and City Tree maintenance throughout all areas of the City; and

Whereas, the City sought to purchase a pre-owned 2002 Ford F-750 Manlift Bucket Truck with Terex 60 ft. working height boom with appropriated city funds not to exceed \$28,000 including taxes and licensing; and

Whereas, the City upon an additional search found a more desirable and less expensive alternative truck available for purchase described as a 1999 International Model 4900 Manlift Bucket Truck with a 53 ft. working height boom for a purchase price with taxes and licensing not to exceed \$15,500.00; and

Whereas, the City purchased the vehicle based on and within the authority of Resolution 526, but since a different vehicle was acquired than the one identified in the earlier resolution, City Council ratification of that purchase is required.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, the City Council of North Bonneville, Washington hereby reaffirms a special market condition pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) and ratifies the purchase of a 1999 International Model 4900 Manlift Bucket Truck with a 53 ft. working height boom for a purchase price with taxes and licensing not to exceed \$15,500.00. The City Clerk is hereby directed to consummate the sale and the Mayor is authorized to sign any title documents necessary to complete the purchase and sale.
