

**City of North Bonneville
Resolution Number 530**

A Resolution of the City of North Bonneville, Finding Reason for Termination of North Bonneville Public Development Authority and Setting Hearing Date

Whereas, On November 12, 2013, the City of North Bonneville adopted Ordinance 1028, creating the North Bonneville Public Development Authority, (NBPDA) under RCW 35.21.730-.755 and adopting a charter and by-laws for the NBPDA.; and

Whereas, the Council finds the NBPDA has operated as an entity since its creation, with a stated public purpose of generating income to the City for additional law enforcement, drug awareness, and other public benefits set forth in the ordinance; and

Whereas, the Council finds the NBPDA has been only marginally successful in generating income for the City, and has required high-interest loans to keep it in operation; and

Whereas, the Council finds the City is dissatisfied with the financial management and reporting provided by the NBPDA; and

Whereas, the City wishes to divest itself of its association with the NBPDA, either through termination and dissolution or through sale to an entity that has similar goals, or as the Council may decide after a public hearing; and

Whereas, the Council has set August 13, 2019 as the date for a public hearing as required under Section 24 of Ordinance 1028, and the Mayor shall cause staff to notify the NBPDA of the date of this hearing forthwith.


Now, therefore, be it resolved, the City Council of North Bonneville, Washington hereby finds the recitals set forth above as the basis to consider terminating the NBPDA and sets August 13, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. as the date and time for a public hearing on the matter.


