City of North Bonneville Resolution Number 532

A Resolution of the City of North Bonneville, Declaring Special Market Conditions Under RCW 39.04.280(1)(B) to purchase used 4x4 Trucks.

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville is a Washington Municipality as defined in RCW 39.04.101; and

Whereas, the City maintains Vehicles and equipment used by the Public Works Department for maintenance and operations; and

Whereas, the City of North Bonneville Public Works Department has need for an 4x4 Extended Cab Pickup Truck and a 4x4 Crew Cab Flat Bed Truck to adequately address the needs of the City; and

Whereas, the City's existing trucks are past their useful life and need to be replaced with a newer and more adequately sized models; and

Whereas, the City intends to purchase these pre-owned Truck(s) under special market conditions due to the unique circumstances surrounding the potential purchase at a Public Utility District #1 surplus equipment sale by bids to be opened August 6, 2019, and provided the winning bid(s) by the City is favorable, purchase the vehicle(s) and obtain Council ratification of the purchase at the next Council meeting; and

Whereas, the City has an opportunity to purchase said truck(s) which are a 2012 Chevrolet Colorado 4x4 Extended Cab with 99,200 miles and a 2005 Chevrolet 3500 4x4 Crew Cab – 8' 6" Flat Bed with 132,825 miles;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, the City Council of North Bonneville, Washington hereby declares a special market condition pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) and authorizes the purchase, upon a favorable bid at said surplus sale, of one or both of the 2012 Chevrolet Colorado 4x4 Extended Cab and the 2005 Chevrolet 3500 4x4 Crew Cab - 8' 6" Flat Bed for a total purchase price with taxes and licensing not to exceed \$20,000.00. The City Council shall ratify upon purchase of said truck at its first regular council meeting. The City Clerk is hereby directed to consummate the sale and the Mayor is authorized to sign any title documents necessary to complete the purchase and sale.
