Summary:

This position is responsible for mowing, trimming, and edging lawns in parks, sidewalks, islands, and medians, picking up litter and branches, and performs maintenance of all facets of groundskeeping. Reports to the Public Works Supervisor or Maintenance Worker II's for scheduling and direction.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Mow, trim and edge lawns in parks, sidewalks, islands, and medians using appropriate equipment.
2. Maintain City mowing schedule.
3. Pull weeds, prune shrubs, and perform other landscaping related duties, including picking up garbage, branches, or other debris.
4. As directed, perform pressure washing, watering, trail and road sweeping.
5. Operate a variety of equipment including hand and riding mowers, pressure washers, leaf blowers, hand tools, including shovels, picks, weed eaters, edgers, hand saws and portable power and non-power equipment in a safe and efficient manner.
6. Respond to public inquiries in a courteous manner referring to the Public Works Supervisor when appropriate.
7. Perform other duties as assigned.

Knowledge and Ability to:

- Be a self-starter capable of performing duties independently.
- Perform safe and effective operation of landscaping and grounds maintenance equipment, basic hand tools, and small power tools.
- Follow safety rules and policies.
- Operate a variety of equipment including hand and riding mowers, pressure washers, leaf blowers, hand tools, including shovels, picks, weed eaters, edgers, hand saws and portable power and non-power equipment in a safe and efficient manner.
- Communicate and apply people skills to interact with co-workers, supervisors, and the public, and receive work directions.
