



Temporary Utility Payment Plan

The North Bonneville Municipal Code, Title 13, Public Utilities, Paragraph 13.04.050, states:

"If a person wishes to make payment agreements, they shall do so by way of a water/sewer payment agreement. A property owner in billing arrears whose service has not been shut off for non-payment shall provide a minimum 50% payment of their unpaid utility balance. If the property owner has multiple accounts payment arrangements can only be made on one account at a time. The property owner is responsible for the tenant's unpaid bills. The unpaid balance is subject to additional late fees and must be paid off prior to the next billing"

I agree to the following utility payment plan in order to bring my water/sewer account balance down to zero. The unpaid balance is subject to additional late fees and must be paid off prior to the next billing cycle or specified installment plan. If my unpaid utility payment has not been paid in accordance to the specified plan or paid in full by the date stated in this agreement, additional late fees will be charged per infraction, the water service shall be discontinued until the balance has been fully paid, together with a \$60.00 turn-on fee and accumulation of per diem base rate charges.
