

Temporary Utility Payment Plan

The North Bonneville Municipal Code, Title 13, Public Utilities, Paragraph 13.04.050 states:

"If a person wishes to make payment agreements, they shall do so by way of a water/sewer payment agreement. A property owner in billing arrears whose service has not been shut off for non-payment shall provide a minimum 50% payment of their unpaid utility balance. If the property owner has multiple accounts payment arrangements can only be made on one account at a time. The property owner is responsible for the tenant's unpaid bills. The unpaid balance is subject to additional late fees and must be paid off prior to the next billing"

I agree to the following utility payment plan in order to bring my water/sewer account balance down to zero prior to the next billing cycle which will occur_____. The unpaid balance is subject to the additional late fees and must be paid off prior to the next billing cycle. If my unpaid utility payment has not been paid in full by the date stated in this agreement, the water service shall be discontinued until the balance has been fully paid, together with a \$60.00 turn-on fee.
